Junction City/Harrisburg/Monroe Habitat for Humanity is building safe affordable homes for families **RIGHT HERE, RIGHT NOW.**

We know you want to make a difference in your neighborhood. Junction City/Harrisburg/Monroe Habitat for Humanity Partner Families Give Back to The Tri-Counties. In 2018 alone, our Harrisburg families paid \$15,244 in property taxes to their community!

In our local communities, having a decent paying job no longer guarantees people being able to purchase a home. The average cost of a home in Junction City is over \$300,000. The average rent for a two-bedroom apartment costs \$1,100 per month!!!

Your past support of Junction City/Harrisburg/Monroe Habitat for Humanity has built 24 homes throughout our area. **Homes where families have thrived!** We educate them about finances, home ownership and volunteerism. It pays to have a family living in a Habitat Home that is decent, safe, and AFFORDABLE.

Junction City/Harrisburg/Monroe Habitat for Humanity builds safe, modest homes, using volunteer labor and selling them to working families with an affordable mortgage. That is a real solution to combatting the out of control housing prices. **Affordable housing is at a crisis in the State of Oregon and we are part of the solution.**

We want our neighbors to stay right here in our community. We want our families to stop worrying if they should pay their rent or buy groceries.
